Instrument options available:

- Grade P-6: Beginner ABC Music Program (see details below)

- Grade 2-6: Guitar
- Grade 3-6: All of the above plus flute, violin and clarinet.
- Grade 5-6: All of the above plus saxophone.

The **BEGINNER ABC MUSIC PROGRAM** is a perfect introduction to music for kids of any age. This fun and stimulating program provides students with the opportunity to try a variety of instruments over 2 terms and also incorporates lots of fun musical games and activities.

Instruments trialled in the ABC program

- Junior ABC
Prep-Grade 2: Recorder (a good lead into flute), keyboard, 3/4 guitar, voice, percussion, ukulele, tin whistle and violin.
- Senior ABC:
Grade 3-6: Keyboard, guitar, percussion, violin, flute, clarinet, saxophone, and ukulele.
